Opening Day – Tuesday, Sept 6

Opening day is a half day from 8:30 to 11:00 am for all students except kindergarten. Kindergarten families will follow the schedule in the letter they received in July from the school instead. Contact the school if you have not received this letter.

Class lists (including classroom number, grade and teacher name) will be posted by 8:00 am at the front of the school in two locations. The locations are on the windows of the library and on a rolling white board near the front entrance door. Additionally, there will be maps in both areas to locate classrooms. All classroom exterior doors will have the room number, grade and teacher name posted to help locate your child's classroom(s). Please have students line up at their outside classroom door when the warning bell rings at 8:25 am. Teachers will admit students into class after the next bell rings at 8:30 am. Please to do not send all school supplies on the first day. Only send a pencil case with a few items such as a pencil, pen, scissors, eraser, crayons, etc. You can send a snack as recess will be at 10:00-10:15 am. Students will dismiss from the same exterior door at 11 am. Please let your students know that there is the potential for movement after the first day as unexpected changes in enrollment can require adjustments to classes.
