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I would like to thank the staff, PAC, parents and students for all their time, generosity and efforts in making December a wonderful month. We started December off with communicating where students are at in their learning with report cards and Parent-Teacher Conferences. The last two weeks of school were incredibly busy and enjoyable with the first ever virtual Christmas Concert, Red/Green and Holiday Sweater Day, Christmas Door Decorating, Christmas Movies, French Immersion Christmas Magic Show, as well as many class celebrations.

Kindergarten Registration for French Immersion will be held the week of Jan 11-15 and for English during the week of Jan 18-22. The process is different this year. Pre-registration will occur online to avoid lineups at schools. This will determine the order of registration. Completion of registration will require coming to the school at a later date. During January and February, Grade 5 Students will be participating in the Middle Years Development Instrument (MDI). Grade 4 students will be participating in the Satisfaction Survey as well as the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA).

A reminder that Ecole Mission Central Elementary is a Scent-Free School. Several staff have severe allergies to scents and fragrances. I ask that you join me in ensuring that we have a Safe and Scent-Free workplace for our students and staff.

Please make sure that students are dressed properly as the weather can be very cold and damp this time of the year. # **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR 2021-22**



Due to COVID safety measures, we are making some changes to the kindergarten registration process.

#### FRENCH IMMERSION: Monday January 11 at 9am to Friday January 15 at 9pm

If you have chosen French Immersion as the best program for your child, then you need to pre-register your child starting <u>at 9am Monday, January 11, 2021</u>. This link will become live <u>starting at 9am</u> and will be available until 9pm Friday January 15: <u>Click on this link to fill in the pre-registration form (French K)</u>

#### You will be asked to provide the following information:

-The name and date of birth of your child

-The name, phone number and email address of a parent/guardian who can be contacted to complete the registration process at the school

- -Your child's French Immersion Catchment School (Ecole Christine Morrison or Ecole Mission Central) -If your child already has a sibling enrolled in the French Immersion program
- -(if necessary) Cross-boundary request (yes/no)

#### Some important information for you:

Kindergarten French Immersion spots are assigned on a <u>first-come, first-served basis</u>. Students with older siblings in the French Immersion Program of Choice are given priority access to the program. **PLEASE BE ADVISED:** Submitting this form <u>does not</u> guarantee your child a French Immersion spot. This is simply a Pre-Registration form.

#### ENGLISH: Monday January 18 at 6am to Friday January 22 at 6pm

If you have chosen English as the best program for your child, then you need to pre-register your child starting **at 6am Monday, January 18, 2021.** This link will be available until 6pm Friday January 22: <u>Click on this link to</u> <u>fill in the pre-registration form (English K)</u>

#### You will be asked to provide the following information, please come prepared

-The name and date of birth of your child

-The name, phone number and email address of a parent/guardian who can be contacted to complete the registration process at the school

-(if necessary) Cross-boundary request (yes/no)

**PLEASE BE ADVISED:** Submitting this form <u>does not</u> guarantee your child a spot in our school. You will also be required to complete the Registration Form and provide proof of your child's age at the school during your allotted time arranged with Mrs. Godley.

Mrs. Godley, our school's Administrative Assistant, will contact you to make an appointment with you at a later date for you to submit the required documentation and registration papers. She will send the information and package after the respective registration weeks.
